EVENT RULES

BFA Licence :

Fencers must be individual members of British Fencing with a **COMPETE LICENCE** and must either reside in Kent or be bona fide members of a BFA registered club or school based within the county of Kent. BFA licence cannot be upgraded to Compete on the day.

Equipment Rules :

Fencers must use equipment in line with age category – no exceptions will be made.

Blades sizes allowed for each age group :

Under 10 : size 0

Under 12 : size 3

Under 14 : size 3

Fencers will not be allowed to compete with a weapon of incorrect size.

Lame bibs are not necessary.

Full length socks must be worn.

All fencers must wear clothing that complies with current regulations.

Event Rules :

The rules for competitions of both the KCAFU and British Fencing apply to these events.

Depending on entry numbers, boys and girl events may have to be combined for the pools. Direct Elimination will be split between boys and girls.

Covid Protocols:

The covid protocols will be confirmed to entrants ahead of the event, and will be in line with BFA guidance and venue requirements. A contact email is required please.
